My dream is basic, atleast the core of it is.

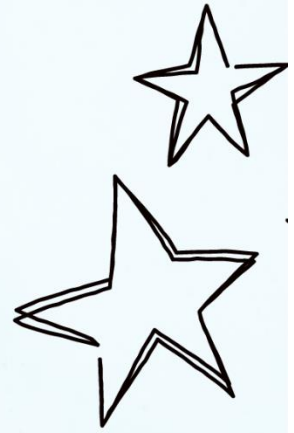
